






EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

None of us, sitting around the kitchen table in 2012, would have guessed Nik's Wish to help young adults would have come this far this fast. From the first fund-raiser, Nik's Home Run, to delivering our first wish to Nate O'Neil, the journey has been as challenging as it has been rewarding. Each time, when there seemed to be and obstacle too big to overcome, a door would open and the answer would appear.

In 2016 the challenges were more demanding than ever before. There were an amazing number of wish requests pouring in each month. Some requests were, by their very nature, extremely difficult to fulfill. Wishes like meeting the Dixie Chicks, Metallica and the cast from Hamilton ranked the highest in the wish difficulty category. Only by the persistence of sincerely dedicated wish coordinators did these happen. They just would not give up until the right person was found to make the wish come true. There were many family trips and some interesting experiences as our patients learned to surf and swim with dolphins. One thing for sure is that there were plenty of smiles created in 2016!



FUND-RAISING SUMMARY

2016 brought new challenges as the number of wish requests grew. The foundation's Executive Committee went into hyper fund-raising speed as we added several new events. We were pleasantly surprised to have the Auburn High School National Honor Society select us for a 3rd year in a row, raising a record \$4140.

We introduced a new type of fund-raiser with the Nothing Butt Smiles Pork Roast Sales. Smokin Coop BBQ partnered with us to sell over 110 smoked pork roasts (pork butts) and raised over \$3500.

We added a new event on the rooftop of the Old Republic Building in downtown Chicago. It was our first ever fund-raising event in the Windy City and was well attended. We were delighted with a perfect evening for an outdoor cocktail and a magnificent view over Michigan Avenue.

We were very honored to have two families request that donations be made to the foundation in lieu of flowers after their loved one passed. It is a strong reminder of just how important our mission is to the entire family.

Nik's Home Run continues to be our signature event. We had a record attendance and added some surprises including: 3 guest patient speakers we've been honored to serve: Homer our baseball mascot: and a virtual run with 32 participants from 5 different countries. Even with all of our efforts, we would have come short of our need had it not been for a generous \$100,000 donation from a private party. We are so very blessed to be able to continue to enrich the lives of young adults with vour support.
