I didn't know how I would ever fulfill my son, Nik's last wish to fill the gap for young adults fighting cancer. I was blessed to have family and friends help to figure out how to get us started to fulfill Nik's wish. Eight years after Nik planted the seed, your continuing support has nurtured it, and ogether we have delivered over 175 wishes in 32 states. I think if Nik were here today, he'd say, "See, mom, I told you they needed a wish!"

This year was record breaking as we accepted 53 wish applications and delivered 50 wishes. This year's Wishers had such a variety of wishes, yet each one accomplished the same goal – love life, love those in your life, and forget about cancer for just a while. Our team of amazing Wish Makers helped their Wishers go on family trips to Hawaii, Disney, Yellowstone, New York City, and Phoenix. Some met their favorite stars like Guy Fieri and Luke Bryan. Each wish was special in its very own way because it was a gift especially made for them!




2019 FINANCIALS (UNAUDITED)
