Dear Friends,

2022 brought a rainbow of hope that the world would return to "normal," and that our wish doors would fully open. "Normal" isn't something that families fighting cancer can relate to, however because of your continued support, wishes brought HOPE & JOY and some "normalcy" to 50 young adults and their loved ones fighting cancer. We are so grateful for all our donors, volunteers and event sponsors that helped us through another challenging year.

We were delighted to be able to deliver some amazing memories for brave, young cancer warriors and their families. Alaska fishing, dolphin swimming, honeymoons, pianos, Graceland, Hawaii, Disney, Cowboys, New York, and puppy love; each of the 50 wishes brought HOPE & JOY during a tough fight. Many of our immune compromised wishers were waiting for the uncertainty and safety of travel to improve before taking their wish. 2022 was to be their year! Sadly, cancer took the lives of 4 of our wishers before their wish could be delivered and 2 of our delivered wishes were last wishes. This was the most loss that we have seen in a single year. It was a stark reminder that cancer waits for no one.

2022 was also a year of soul searching for Nik's Wish. We have always been a 100% volunteer charity. Our Board of Directors took a hard look at our future to make sure that we are set up to deliver wishes as long as young adults are fighting. They determined that Nik's

Wish needs to evolve to a more sustainable structure with staff. We're thrilled to announce the hiring of our very first employee, Development Director, Tammy English. Tammy will be working closely with our Board to develop relationships and grow our donor base. She is an amazing individual with a huge heart. We are anxious for you to meet her!

Entering the 4th quarter of the year, it appeared we would not meet our annual fundraising goal. At Thanksgiving, we had raised just over \$260,000. By year's end, we needed to reach \$300,000 to stay on budget. It seemed doubtful that we could close such a big of gap in such a short time! Our supporters, especially our Hope Heroes, leaned in like never before to boost our results to over \$350,000. It was truly a Christmas Miracle!

As we embark on the new year, our wish pipeline is bursting with wish requests. We are blessed to be able to BRING HOPE & JOY to these brave cancer warriors. As Hindy, fighting Acute Myeloid Leukemia, reminded us "Sometimes going out and doing fun stuff is more healing than medicine." 


